Join us for a half-day training led by Dr. Tina Cheuck (http://www.studentparentjoy.org/) designed to better equip Cuesta Faculty and Staff in serving the needs of our student parents.

Our activities will include a "Data Dive: Uncovering the Student Parent Population"

which will provide an overview of the student parent population both nationwide and at Cuesta, a session devoted to "Embracing Diversity by Exploring Identity Markers and Power Dynamics" focused on contemporary frameworks for understanding differences among diverse student parent populations, and "Centering Intersectionality in Student Parent Experiences" that will provide practical guidance for developing strategies for best serving this population in our teaching, counseling, and student services.

Participants will emerge from the training with the following outcomes:

- Increased awareness of the student parent population, their needs for college completion, and expanded understanding of the unique needs and challenges faced by this diverse population.
- Strategies for fostering a culturally responsive and inclusive classroom environment for student parents.
- A data-informed vocabulary for discussing and addressing the needs of student parents within the higher education context.
- Practical skills, strategies, and concrete action plans to effectively adapt current teaching practices to accommodate the needs of student parents.
- A collaborative learning environment that drives systemic change for student parent success, while empowering participants to take ownership of their roles on campus as change agents.

Dr. Tina Cheuck is a mother scholar, educator, and advocate focused on empowering and imagining futures that sustain and cultivate the learning, growth, and success of minoritized groups in

postsecondary education. She is currently an assistant professor in the School of Education at California Polytechnic State University in San Luis Obispo.


