We estimate that, over the course of this fund's lifetime, Cuesta Music Faculty have raised close to 100k. Mostly, these funds go directly to supporting students, positively affecting our program recruitment and retention. After the 2017 budget cuts resulted in private lessons being reduced to half, the funds have been since used to supplement the otherwise standard hour students would receive at a four-year university. This has allowed our students to stay competitive in their field, and we look forward to having enough donations to directly pour back into our students again soon.

100% of the proceeds from these concerts benefit the music student scholarship fund. Our scholarship winners work full time, attend school full time, and still manage to practice and perform professionally. We are honored to support their dreams and ambitions, and we're so grateful for your contribution in this worthy endeavor.
