Duties/Responsibilities:

Under direct supervision, the Intern will do the following:

- Scan EOPS, CARE, and CalWORKs Application spreadsheet on a daily basis and make contact with new applicants to introduce them to all the services our office can provide;
- Make notes in ConexEd of each meeting with students to ensure that crosscommunication on students is happening throughout the programs;
- Give new students orientations to the campus including visiting important resource areas such as Counseling, Student Success, ASCC, Bookstore, Financial Aid, Career Connections, and the Library;
- Assist in the recruitment, orientation, and registration of students, informing them of Cuesta's educational, vocational, and avocational opportunities;

- Become familiar with current policies and procedures of the EOPS, CalWORKs and CARE programs;
- Establish a schedule consistent with your program requirements and Cuesta's Academic Calendar;
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with Cuesta students and Student Services faculty and staff members;
