## How Do I Change the Screen Resolution?

The following instructions outline how to change the screen resolution for a Windows PC and a Macintosh running OSX.

### **Windows XP**

1. Minimize all open windows by clicking the **Show Desktop** button on the Quick Launch bar.

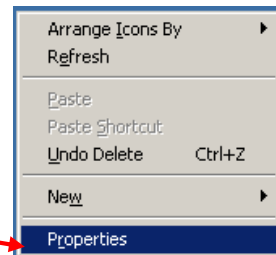


NOTE: If the Show Desktop button is unavailable, manually minimize all open windows.

*The Windows Desktop will be visible.*

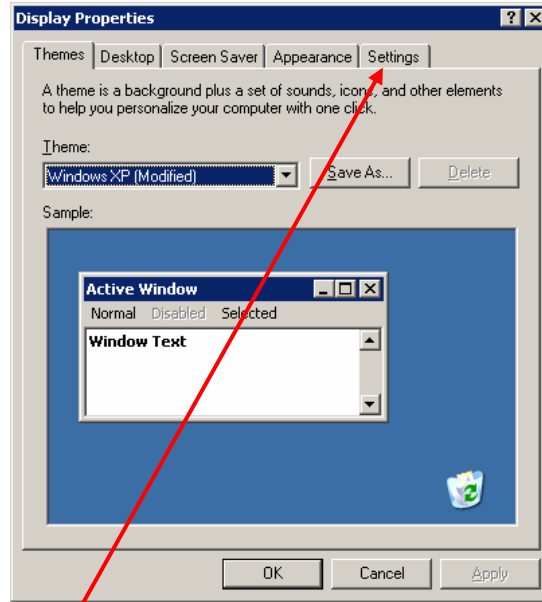
2. Right-mouse click on a blank area of the Desktop.

*A shortcut menu will appear.*



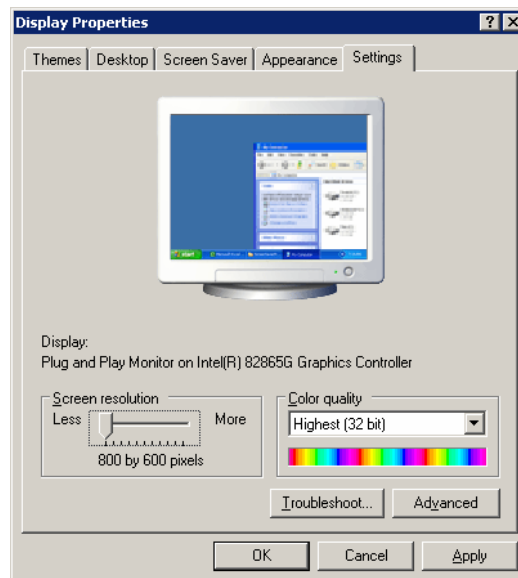
3. Select **Properties** from the shortcut menu.

*The Display Properties dialog will appear.*

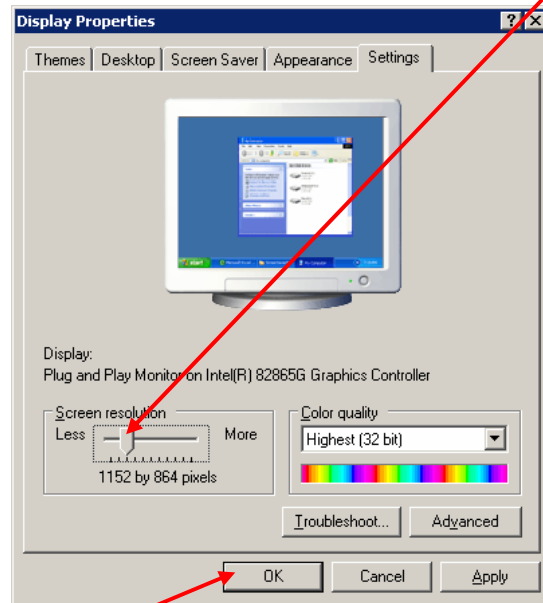


4. Click the **Settings** tab.

*The Display settings tab will be visible.*

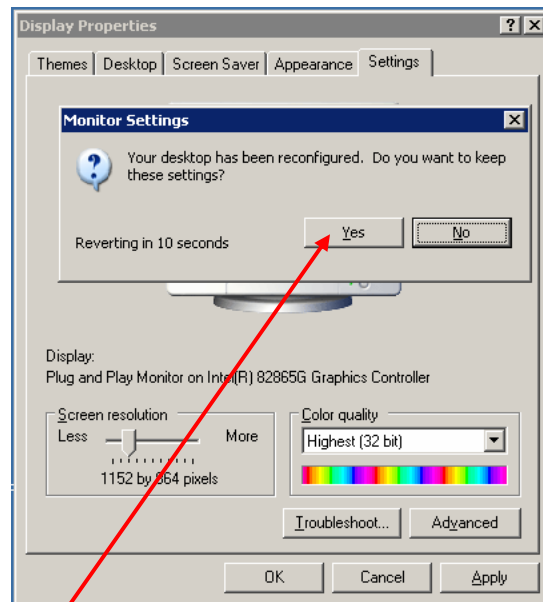


5. Drag the **Screen resolution** slider until the resolution reads **at least 1152 x 864**.



6. Click the **OK** button.

*A Monitor Settings confirmation dialog will appear.*



7. Click the **Yes** button.

*The screen will reflect the new settings. If you are unhappy with the settings, repeat steps 2-7, picking a different resolution.*

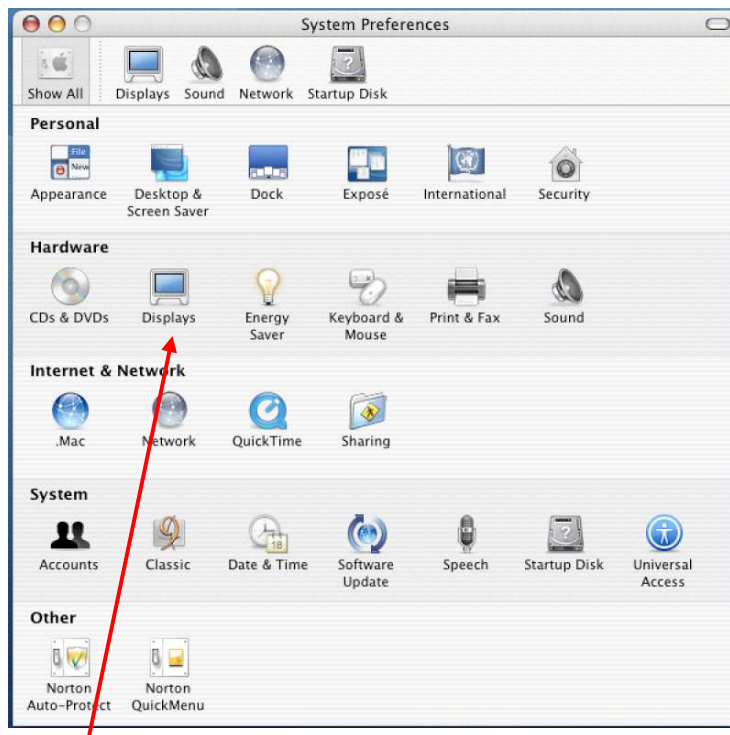
## Apple Macintosh - OSX

1. Select “**System Preferences**” from the Dock.

System Preferences

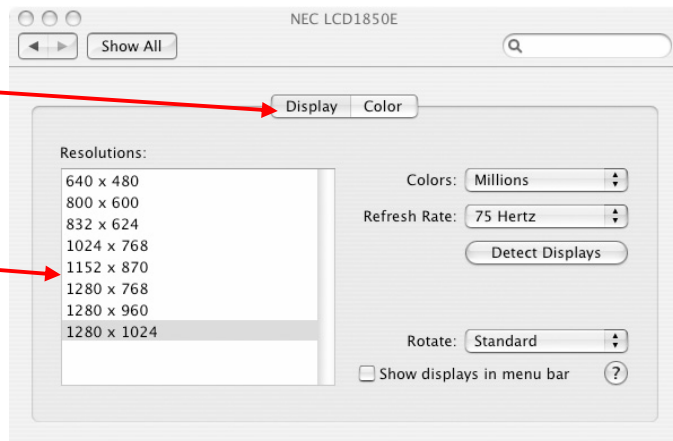


*The System Preferences screen will appear.*



2. Select “**Displays**” under the category, Hardware.

3. Verify that **Display** is selected.



4. Select a resolution of **at least 1152 x 864**.

*The screen will reflect the new resolution.*

5. Select “**Quit System Preferences**”, under System Preferences on the menu bar.
