
Logon Procedures for Instructor Stations in Classrooms

There are two (2) computer configurations for the instructor's stations in Cuesta College classrooms; auto-logon or manual logon. Currently all North County instructor stations are auto-logon. San Luis campus instructor computers are gradually being converted from manual logon to auto-logon, with a conversion target of Spring 2008.

Auto-Logon

When an auto-logon instructor station is turned on, the machine automatically logs in to a default account with access to the internet and client applications (Microsoft Office 2003, Adobe Reader, etc.). An auto-logon computer is easily identifiable because the user not prompted for a username/password. Instead they are taken directly to the Windows Desktop.

When using an auto-logon workstation, an instructor can access their personal drive (P:), group drive (G:) and e-mail account via Citrix. Citrix is available by logging into myCuesta (or by accessing Program Neighborhood, if available).

Manual Logon

If the instructor station does not automatically log into Windows, then it is a manual logon machine. Faculty must log in using their network username and password in order to use that instructor station.
