**Students will need to bring to complete their FAFSA or CA Dream Act:**

- Student's and Parent's Social Security number
- Records of untaxed income such as welfare benefit, Social Security benefit, or child support payments
- Student's and Parent's W-2 forms or records of income earned during 2015
- 2015 bank statements
- Business records
- Permanent resident or DACA card, if you are not a U.S. citizen
- List of colleges you are interested in attending
