Summary of Activities

- Goal is to support adult basic education, English language acquisition, adult secondary education (including high school equivalency/high school diploma), and English Literacy and Civics education.
- Funds support classroom supplies and materials, childcare, professional development, recruitment, and student support services.
- Adult education programs at Cuesta benefit from alignment with career partners (such as Workforce Development Board and One Stop), streamlined enrollment, flexible scheduling, embedded tutoring, and multiple research-supported interventions and classroom practices based on the needs of the student population.

Highlights & Accomplishments

- 633 student enrolled in Adult Education or English as a Second Language (ESL) in 2020/2021.
- 82 students earned a noncredit certificate in 2020/2021.
- Cuesta College offered ESL, Civic and Community Education, High School Equivalency, and Adult Basic Education, with most programs offered at all 3 campuses. All courses provided onsite free childcare.
