Purpose

- To assess familiarity and likelihood of enrollment in Cuesta College courses among South County residents
- > To identify what types of courses and programs South County residents would be interested in taking
- > To identify where, when, and how South County residents would like to have those courses and programs delivered



Responses, Confidence Level, Margin of Error

- > 295 valid responses
- > 95% CI, ± 6 ppts
- > Example: 30% of sample affirms an item. Given the CI, we can be 95% confident that the true population value lies within $30\% \pm 6$ or between 24% and 36%. Given the sample frame of roughly 75,000 residents, this means that we can be 95% confident that between 18,000 and 27,000 South County residents would have affirmed this Item.

Figure 6.6: What is your age?





Figure 6.5: What is your average annual household income?





Figure 1.3: At which of the following Cuesta College sites have you taken courses? Please select all that apply.





Figure 2.5: Likelihood of Taking a Course at Cuesta College in the Future by Age



("Not at all likely" to take a course at Cuesta in the future)





Figure 2.10: Are you familiar with the Cuesta College Promise?






Figure 3.4: For what reasons would you be interested in taking (a) community college course(s)? Please select all that apply.

Figure 4.1: Cuesta College's "Emeritus" program offers lifelong learning classes for free.



Figure 4.2: Interest in Cuesta College's "Emeritus" Program by Age




Figure 5.1: Please indicate your level of interest in taking a course in the following areas.


Figure 4.3: In which of the following locations would you prefer to take a course? Please select all that apply.


Figure 4.4: Which would be your preferred course length at Cuesta College? Please select all that apply.

Preferred Course Delivery Modality


Figure 4.5: What would be your preferred class format? Please select all that apply.
