### PARKING REGULATIONS

- **Parking permits are required for all vehicles parked anywhere on campus property or roadways, Monday through Saturday when classes are in session.** (CC001 Penalty \$39)
- Vehicles are prohibited from backing into parking spaces, parking over the lines/taking two spaces, blocking the flow of traffic, or obstructing walkways. (CC008 Penalty \$34)
- All vehicles must park in the direction of traffic on roadways. (CC006 Penalty \$34)
- Motorcycles must park in designated areas only, and may not park in regular parking zones or on the roadways. (CC006 Penalty \$34)
- Student parking is not allowed in any portion of the inner campus. (CC006 Penalty \$34)
- Vehicles parked on campus for more than 24 consecutive hours are subject to citation or being towed at the owner's expense (CC007 Penalty \$34)
- Any forgery, tampering or defacing of parking permits shall invalidate that permit and the permit may be seized. (CC002 Penalty \$68)
- All vehicles with five (5) or more unpaid parking violations, 30 days or more past due may have an "Auto Boot" installed by the Cuesta College Police Department. It will not be removed until all citation fees are paid, or a payment plan is signed and the initial payment made. Make payments at the Cuesta College Police Department building 6600. A hold may

be placed on a student's transcripts and DMV vehicle registration for nonpayment.

- Parking Zones:
  - a. Staff Zones (Green) No student parking allowed. (CC006 Penalty \$34)
  - b. Loading Zones (Yellow) Limited to commercial parking, 30 minute maximum. (CC005 Penalty \$68)
  - c. Handicap Zones (Blue) Handicap parking only, with authorized DMV permit and Cuesta College parking permit. (22507.8 CVC Penalty \$275)
  - d. Red Zones (Red) No parking allowed. (CC003 Penalty \$68)
  - e. 20 Minute Zones (Green) for 20 minutes only. (CC003 Penalty \$68)
  - f. Bus Zone (White) For buses only (CC003 \$68)
- Skateboards, roller skates, roller blades and scooters are prohibited anywhere on campus property. (CC011 Penalty \$36)
- Bicycles shall be ridden on campus roads in designated bicycle lanes only, may not be ridden on the inner campus, and shall be parked only in designated bike racks. Violators may have their bikes impounded and stored if parked illegally. (CC012 Penalty \$36)
- No dogs or animals are allowed on campus. Service animals that are trained and registered as animals to assist those who have a disability are exempt. (CC013 Penalty \$36)

The Cuesta College Board of Trustees has established Rules and Regulations to control traffic, parking and regulation of vehicles on the college campus, as prescribed under Section 21113 of the California Vehicle Code.

The Cuesta College Police Department also enforces all other California Vehicle and Penal Codes. Speeding, failure to stop at stop signs, and other vehicle code violations may result in a court traffic citation and/or a student misconduct report.

The program of “pay for parking” on campus is based on the concept that parking facilities must be paid for by the user. Money collected for parking permits reimburses the college for the cost of operating and managing parking facilities. Enforcement of the parking regulations is the responsibility of the Cuesta College Police Department.

In order to provide safe parking for students, staff and visitors, we ask that you please be aware of the following regulations.

Enforcement of parking in red zones, handicapped zones, loading zones and 20 minute zones is in effect at all times.

**THE SPEED LIMIT IN ALL CAMPUS PARKING LOTS IS 10 MILES PER HOUR.**

You may appeal a citation by obtaining a Citation Appeal form at the Cuesta College Police Dept. or online under the Public Safety tab at [www.Cuesta.edu](http://www.Cuesta.edu). Appeals are reviewed within 30 days of the citation date. No appeals will be considered after this date.

### PARKING PERMITS

- **Parking permits are required for all vehicles parked anywhere on campus property or roadways, Monday through Saturday when classes are in session. (CC001 Penalty \$39)**
  - Student semester parking permits may be purchased online through *myCuesta*, the Cashier’s Office, or Cuesta College Police Dept. at SLO-Bldg. 6600 or North County-Bldg, N1021. Staff permits are available at Cuesta College Police Dept.
  - All parking lots, except Lots 1 and 7, have daily permit machines that allow you to purchase a one-day parking permit for \$4. Permit machines take one (1) dollar bills or credit/debit cards. Daily permits are also available at the Cuesta College Police Dept.
  - Student semester permits **must** be clearly displayed in the following methods:
    - Permanently affixed on the interior **lower right corner** of the front windshield.
    - Suspended from the rear view mirror on/in a plastic hanger facing forward (towards front of vehicle).
    - Motorcycles or mopeds must display permits on the front forks or cowling.
- Note:** Do NOT affix semester parking permits to vehicle bumper, rear window, or display on dashboard.
- Parking permits are not required or enforced during the FIRST week of each semester.**
