What is the ITRC?

- Three tenured faculty from different divisions, two management employees
 - Jason Curtis (VPI), Maria Escobedo (Dean), Katy Dittmer (Chair), Mike Kinter (Math), Wes Sims(English)
- Evaluating body: considers each element of evaluation and issues an overall evaluation, in the form of a recommendation to the district regarding second contract, third contract, and tenure (7.14.2; 7.19-20)
- ITRC's evaluation is based on review of documentation provided by CFM (contract faculty member), DTC (division tenure committee), and manager
- ITRC has contractual obligation to address problems (7.19-20)

What do you need to know about the ITRC's role in your tenure-track process?



- It is meant to be a process of self-reflection, mentorship, and support.
- We all want you to achieve tenure!
- Each Fall you will produce an electronic Self-Maintained File (SMF) to support your case for tenure
- The ITRC focuses on 4 documents in your SMF:
 - Self-evaluation
 - Student evaluations
 - Peer evaluation
 - Management evaluation
