ATI TEAS ASSESSMENT TEST POLICY, DATES, & TEST DAY INFORMATION
FOR RN APPLICANTS in SEPTEMBER 2022

Test Dates: October 10, 11, 12, 13, 14

Time: Check-in at 8:00 – 8:15 am. Test begins at 8:30 am.

Check-in at 1:00 – 1:15 pm. Test begins at 1:30 pm.

Note: Late arrivals are disruptive to others and cannot be allowed to enter the room to test.

Timed Test: The TEAS is a 3 ½ hour timed test.

Location: Cuesta College San Luis Obispo Campus, Bldg. 3400/Rm. 3414 (High Tech Ctr – 2nd Floor)

Cuesta College Nursing Department ATI TEAS Testing Policies:

The Cuesta College nursing department offers one complimentary ATI TEAS test per 12-month application cycle to eligible applicants.

- **Taking the ATI TEAS at Cuesta in this application cycle is only available to applicants who:**
 - submit a complete application by the application due date AND
 - have NOT taken an ATI TEAS (Version 7) exam at any location since October 31, 2021
- **Only the first ATI TEAS (Version 7) score within the past 12 months can be accepted.** If you have taken the ATI TEAS since the above date, you are ineligible to test at Cuesta in this application cycle and we will use the score from your previous ATI TEAS version 7 test. **No exceptions to this policy can be made.** Please note that your ATI TEAS report indicates how many times you have taken the exam and how many days have passed since your last attempt.
- **If you tested at Cuesta last year for RN application, you must test again this year as part of the current application.**
- **A minimum Adjusted Individual Total Score of 62% is required.** Applicants with *any* previous ATI TEAS score below 62% are required to show proof of remediation before being eligible to apply to the program. Remediation plans from other schools will be considered. For more information, contact NursingSuccess@cuesta.edu
- **Create an ATI account, username and password, prior to the test date at www.atitesting.com** Check “Cuesta College ADN” as the Institution. *You will need your ATI account username and password to sign in and begin your test. The test start time will not be delayed assisting those without a username and password.*
- **DSPS Accommodations:** Applicants eligible for Disabled Students Programs and Services must request testing accommodations by emailing NursingAdmissions@cuesta.edu immediately after application submission. We will respond quickly, but if you do not hear from us within 72 hours, please resend your email.

Submitting your ATI TEAS score to Cuesta:

- **If you meet the above criteria and take the ATI TEAS at Cuesta during the current application cycle** your score will be automatically received and you do not need to request it from ATI.
- **If you DO NOT take the ATI TEAS at Cuesta in the current application cycle** it is your responsibility to contact ATI and request that they send your *official transcripts* to Cuesta College by the due date stated in the application. To request that ATI send your official transcript to Cuesta, go to their website at: www.atitesting.com. Only official ATI TEAS scores sent directly to Cuesta by ATI can be accepted. No unofficial copies will be accepted. ATI will send you an email confirmation when your TEAS transcripts have been submitted to Cuesta College.

Test Day Information:

- **Parking on Campus:** Parking permits are required. Daily permits are available for \$4 and can be purchased from the self-serve permit machines in all parking lots located on the SLO campus. Machines accept: one-dollar bills (\$1) only, credit cards, Apple & Android Pay. Permit machines do not give change. Building 3400 is easily accessible from parking lots 2, 3, 4 and 5.

- **Test Day Checklist:**

- ✓ Arrive early to purchase a parking permit, find a parking spot and arrive on time for check-in.
- ✓ Bring your photo ID - your name will be checked against our list of eligible applicants.
- ✓ Bring your ATI user name and password.
- ✓ Calculators will be provided.
- ✓ Scratch paper & pencils will also be provided.
- ✓ Please refrain from using scented grooming products for the comfort of other participants.

- **Prohibited Items:**

The following items are NOT allowed in the testing area; please leave them at home or in your vehicle.

Electronic devices: cell phone, laptop, smart watch, digital watch, calculator, headphones, earbuds

Personal items: purse, backpack, computer bag, duffel bag, jacket, hat, sunglasses, dictionary, book

Food or drink. This is only permitted as a documented, medically necessary item.

HOW WILL I KNOW IF I HAVE “PASSED” THE ATI TEAS?

- Applicants must achieve a minimum Adjusted Individual Total Score of 62% on the ATI TEAS to continue in the application process. This score is found on the top right corner of your ATI TEAS report.

WHAT IF I SCORE BELOW 62%?

- Applicants who score below the 62% minimum Adjusted Total Individual Score on any ATI TEAS test become ineligible to participate in the application process at Cuesta and are required to show proof of remediation in order to become eligible to apply in a future application cycle.
