

BP 5000 Components of the Educational Program

The Board of Trustees of the San Luis Obispo County Community College District shall offer a diversified educational program with the following components:

1. Occupational Education

The college offers vocational and technical training in fields where students can be gainfully employed. These programs are designed to further vocational competency and prepare students for employment.

2. Academic Preparation for Transfer to Institutions of Higher Learning

The college offers courses meeting lower division general education requirements and leading to upper division majors.

3. Counseling and Guidance

The college provides a counseling and guidance program designed to help each student select goals and an educational plan consistent with aspirations, interests, and abilities to the fullest potential and to counsel students who need help with personal problems that affect the student's educational success.

4. Academic Support

The college provides support classes and services for students who may have challenges in succeeding in other academic and occupational courses or who may need additional assistance because of a disability.

5. Non-Credit

The college provides non-credit classes designed to help each student meet their personal goals and to provide an avenue for lifelong learning.

6. Community Services

The college provides cultural, recreational, and educational opportunities for the entire community. It is an objective of the San Luis Obispo County Community College District that its facilities and educational program should be of continuing value to the community.
