All are out in clinical rotations now. Having excellent clinical experiences. • Curriculum change: HT waiting to hear status. Changing to 9.5 units, teaching tactical EMS, additional supplies, new skills sheet. (course certificate attestation? Doug Brim); • New morning EMT section at SLO already has 6 students enrolled, 7 in SLO evening class, 15 in NCC eve class.

Based on Strong Workforce Program Launchboard data, Cuesta Paramedic program was able to demonstrate that 95% of student graduates attained the regional living wage. • 3 facility agreements are currently being created or renewed; all others are current. • Paramedic app recruitment 2018: Beginning in May, every student applicant will meet with Mike McDonough; • CoAEMSP: SSR was completed and uploaded on March 30; tentative site visit in Mar 2019; Mike McDonough asked for and received approval from the Advisory Committee for our student standards of patient assessment and skill minimums; Mike needs program surveys returned from allied agencies and will be pestering people on this ☺ • Equipment Update: order placed for 4M series Zoll monitors; requisition is in process for ambulance simulator – first one on a campus in California. Should be installed before Paramedic class starts in Jan. Dr. Easton-Carr asked about security of this vehicle and its contents. Doug Brim raised need to staff this fulltime; Mike has high fidelity adult simulator manikin (Trauma Hal) on his wish-list (looking for finding stream). • Current cohort (class 12) has completed didactic and are in clinical externships • Class 13: new applicants = 25; deadline for online application submittal April 30; Discussion within committee regarding max number of applicants -- Heather stated challenges in ratio of students to instructors (current/past is 6 students to 1); committee agreed that no more than 24 is the right number; per Heather, we need to bolster TA staffing and get them in early in prep for incoming class 13 • Input from Terry Flores: 2 students have struggled in airway management with AMR; everything else he has been happy with. AMR has a new program that guarantees employment with them based on a 2 year commitment.
