New for Summer & Fall 2019: AB 705

More About AB 705

A new law has gone into effect that changes placement into English and math courses for all California Community Colleges. [View Assembly Bill \(https://assessment.cccco.edu/ab-705-implementation\)](https://assessment.cccco.edu/ab-705-implementation)

- AB 705 (Irwin, 2017) is a law that requires California Community Colleges to maximize the probability that students will enter and complete transfer-level coursework in English and math within one year. (<https://assessment.cccco.edu/ab-705-implementation>)
- The law is based on years of research that shows that high school performance information is the best predictor of course completion and success compared to standardized placement exams.
- In fact, students are more likely to complete transfer-level English and math courses when placed into them directly. 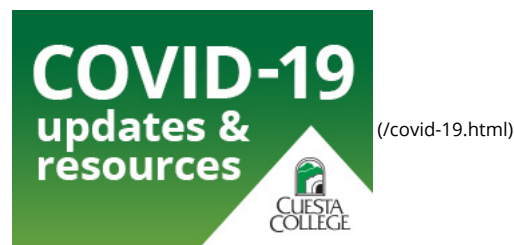
