JOB DESCRIPTION SUMMARY:

Selected applicants will be interviewed to establish a pool of approved Non-Credit Educational Programming for Older Adults instructors for possible part-time teaching assignments in the Workforce, Economic Development and Community Programs Division. Assignments may be day, evening, or weekend classes at the San Luis Obispo Campus, the North County Campus, South County Center or other sites within San Luis Obispo County.

Instructors are especially needed in the following areas:

South San Luis Obispo County/Nipomo- Art (Watercolor, Painting), Adapted Exercise, Yoga, Music Appreciation, Film Appreciation, and Senior Seminar (subjects of special interest and relevant to older adults for enrichment and personal development)

San Luis Obispo, Morro Bay, Cayucos, Cambria - Adapted Exercise, Literature, Music, and Senior Seminar (subjects of special interest and relevant to older adults for enrichment and personal development).

Northern San Luis Obispo County- Music Appreciation, Yoga, Literature, Senior Seminar.

San Luis Obispo Countywide- Classes for seniors in assisted-living facilities- Reminiscing (memory lane activities, crafts, sensory engagement and awareness), Music (memory lane activities, intro to music, participation and sing-along activities), Adapted Exercise.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS & QUALIFICATIONS:

Required:

Bachelor's degree with a major related to the subject of the course taught, and either:

(A) Thirty hours or two semester units of course work or class work in understanding the needs of the older adult taken at an accredited institution of higher education or approved by the district. This requirement may be completed concurrently during the first year of employment as a noncredit instructor; or (B) One year of professional experience working with older adults
OR

Associate degree with a major related to the subject of the course taught; and two years of occupational experience related to the subject of the course taught; and sixty hours or four semester units of coursework or classwork in understanding the needs of the older adult, taken at an accredited institution of higher education or approved by the district. This last requirement may be completed concurrently during the first year of employment as a noncredit instructor.

Desirable:

-Teaching experience in the discipline, community college level preferred;

-Awareness of the philosophy and objectives of California Community Colleges.

Required Documents: Candidates will be required to submit a cover letter, resume, two current letters of recommendation, and unofficial transcripts when applying for this position. *When uploading documents, PDF uploads are preferred.*
