

BP 2105 Election of Student Member

References: Education Code Sections 72023.5 and 72103

1. The student member (trustee) to the Board shall be chosen by the students enrolled in the District as follows:
2. The student member shall be elected by all the students of the student body in a general election held for that purpose. Normally the election will be held in the spring semester so that the office is filled by June 1 for a period of one year from the effective date of office. The student member may be recalled by all the students of the student body in an election held for that purpose in accordance with administrative procedures established by the Superintendent/President.
3. The governing board may authorize the officers of the Associated Students of Cuesta College to appoint, by a majority vote of the officers, a student to serve the remainder of the term if the office becomes vacant by reason of the resignation, recall, or disqualification of an elected student member, or by any other reasons.
4. Candidates for the position may nominate themselves or be nominated by others by the filing of an application certifying that the candidate is eligible for service under the criteria set forth in California law and these policies. The election will be conducted in accordance with administrative procedures established by the President/Superintendent.
