

THE CUESTA PROMISE APPLICATION STEPS

The Cuesta College Promise is a scholarship program available to all San Luis Obispo County high school graduates. The Promise offers all local graduates, including undocumented students--who come straight to Cuesta following their graduation--two years of attendance fee-free (two consecutive fall and spring semesters). The Cuesta Promise will pay fees for students that are a California Resident or AB540 Student.

APPLICATION STEPS

STEP 1: Submit your Cuesta College Fall 2025 admissions application at cuesta.edu/admissionsaid/Apply-Register.

Application period: October 1, 2024-August 1, 2025

STEP 2: Submit your Scholarshlp application (Apply by priority deadline, March 3, 2025, to be considered for additional scholarships) at cuesta.academicworks.com.

Application period: October 5, 2024-August 1, 2025

STEP 3: Complete the <u>FAFSA (studentaid.gov)</u> or the Dream Act application (<u>dream.csac.ca.gov)</u>.

Application period: December 1, 2024-August 1, 2025

STEP 4: Complete the Cuesta College Online Orientation at cuesta.edu/student/studentservices/orientation.

Orientation period: October 1-August 1, 2025

STEP 5: Register for your classes at <u>login.cuesta.edu.</u>

Registration period: Beginning May 2025-August 2025

To earn a second fee-free year, you must complete more than 50% of units attempted and earn a GPA of 2.00 or higher during your first year on the promise, and complete a FAFSA or Dream Act application for 2026-2027 by <u>August 1st. 2026</u>.

Met the academic requirements? Then simply register for classes the next consecutive year and your fees will be paid!
