

How to Register for Commencement

If you graduated the previous fall, or are graduating this current spring or upcoming summer you're eligible to participate in the Spring Commencement Ceremony. You only need to register for yourself as a graduate; guests do not need to register.

1. Follow the link provided on the [Commencement Website](#) or in the e-mail sent to graduates.
2. Select the appropriate Commencement Group. Commencement is divided into five groups based on Areas of Study. We encourage you to join the group for your Area of Study so you can walk with your classmates, but you can select the ceremony time that works best for your schedule.
 - a. Not sure what your Area of Study is? Check out the [Area of Study](#) webpage for more information.
 - b. Are you receiving multiple degrees or certificates? Please pick only one Commencement Group to join, as spaces are limited.
3. You'll be directed to Cuesta Connect. Log in using your my.cuesta ID and password.

4. Once you are logged in, you will see the page for the Group that you selected. Read the description to confirm this is the Group you want to attend, then click the blue “Register” button.

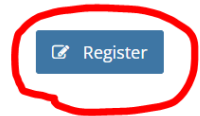
