Connecting a Mac laptop to Cuesta's Eduroam Wi-Fi Network

Eduroam is a worldwide network of research and education institutions that broadcast the eduroam wireless network.

If a wireless device is properly configured for eduroam it will automatically connect at any participating institution. Cal Poly is the closest participating institution, to search for others visit the <u>eduroam U.S. Connectors website</u>.

Please note: If you are connecting a Cuesta issued device the Wi-Fi should connect automatically and may utilize a different network (managed devices, for all employee issued machines), do not change the network on Cuesta issued laptops.

To set up your macOS device to automatically connect to Cuesta's wireless access:

- 1. Select the wireless icon on the Mac menu bar.
- 2. Ensure the Wi-Fi slider is set to On
- 3. Under Other Networks,

select eduroam

4. In the Username box,

enter your Cuesta email address.

5. In the password box,

enter your Cuesta password.

- 6. Click Join
- 7. A "Verify Certificate" window will appear.

Click Show Certificate.

- 8. The validated certificate is for: radius.cuesta.edu
- 9. Click on **Continue**.
- 10. Your device will now automatically connect to eduroam when on campus.
