

STEM Club Cost Proposal - Spring 2025

Asking for: \$3000 - To cover the cost of spring semester field trips, and food for students
*NTE:\$3,500

Note: Fundraising money is being used to cover the cost of *all* spring experiments and demonstrations, as well as the entry fee for one of the field trips

Field Trip Interest and Attendance:

Stanford Linear Accelerator - Fall 2024:

25 max students allowed, 38 students signed up - 13 students did not get to go

Monterey Bay Aquarium - Spring 2025:


35 students signed up & attended

Diablo Canyon Power Plant - Spring 2025:

30 students signed up & attended

Gladiator Paintball Park - Spring 2025:

35 students attended

Expenses:

Field Trips:

1. Vandenberg Space Force Base - April 23rd:

Transportation for 26-40 Students:

SLO Safe Ride Charter Bus Quote:

Vehicle: 55-Passenger Prevost Motor Coach

Price Per Vehicle: \$1,870.00

Hours: 10:00 am - 4:00 pm

Note: This is the cheapest option after consulting with three other companies

Entry Fee for 40 Students:

Free

Lunch for 40 Students:

Students will pack their own lunch

2. Downing Planetarium at Fresno State - February 22nd:

Transportation for 30 Students:

- Parking: free on weekends
- Carpooling with other students, 6 cars, 5 people in each

Gas Reimbursement:

Average MPG = 27.5 mpg. 344 miles to destination and back = 12.5 gallons

12.5 gallons x \$5 per gallon x 6 cars = \$375

Entry Fee for 30 Students:

\$6 each x 30 = \$180

Paid for by fundraising money

Lunch for 30 students:

In n Out: Cheeseburger combo = \$10 after tax

\$10 x 30 = \$300

3. Tour of Promega Corporation, San Luis Obispo - March 17th:

Free tour, no transportation costs, lunch not provided

Experiments/ Demonstrations:

1. Heart dissection demo - February 21st
\$19.95 on Amazon - Paid for by fundraiser money
2. Liquid Nitrogen Superconductor Experiment - April 11th
Paid for by Physical Sciences Department
3. Drone Obstacle Course Building Challenge - February 28th
\$30 for 2 drones - Paid for by fundraiser money
4. Invisibility shields - March 14th
Paid for by fundraiser money

Food:

1. Pizza (for half the meetings) - Feb. 28th, Mar. 21st, Apr. 25th, May 9th

Costco 18" pizza (feeds 6 people)	\$9.95 per pizza
40 students (average) / 6 = 6.7 pizzas per meeting. = 7 pizzas per meeting	\$69.65 per meeting
7 Pizzas x 4 meetings	\$278 for 4 meetings
	Total pizza cost: \$278

2. Snacks (chips, cookies) - Jan. 31st, Feb 21st, Mar. 14th, Apr. 11th
Costco variety chips: \$23
Cookies: \$10
Total snack cost: \$33 x 4 meetings = \$134

Fundraisers and Income:

Conclusion:

The highlighted expenses are ones we do not currently have the funds to cover.

Total expenses highlighted added up = \$2957

The STEM Club is asking for **\$3000** to cover the discussed expenses.

We are asking for a **minimum of \$2500** to cover at least transportation to both out of town field trips, and pizza for our meetings.
