**Section 3: Student Equity Reflection**

Composers are just asked to showcase what they have learned over the last three years of equity work and appraise what efforts, if any, should continue into the next three years of the SEP cycle.


For each of the 5 SEA metrics, Composers must explore data, establish equity goals, select DI groups, and propose new or expand existing strategies for identified DI groups.

**Section 11: Intensive Focus**

After sifting through data, sitting with current inequities, and creating relevant equity strategies across SEA Metrics, planning teams must synthesize and select 1-3 DI student groups to "intensely focus" on during the 2025-2028 SEP cycle.

Phase	Icon	Key Activities
<b>BUILD</b>		Form an equity planning team, build capacity and commitments for the year-long planning process, and review 2022-23 Student Equity Plan (SEP). As planning, reviewing, and developing individual priorities.
<b>LEARN</b>		Facilitate Introduction to Student Equity Plan presentation to all campus community members. Convene teams to understand the state of equity and review data.
<b>CRAFT</b>		Work collaboratively with teams assigned to write the new elements of the SEP as equity goals for the next three years, discuss and propose new or revised equity metrics, strategies, and outcomes to make the campus more equitable for meeting the need towards our commitment to make the community a more equitable place by 2028.
<b>COMMIT</b>		Share the SEP with stakeholders, seek feedback on feedback, and present to gain buy-in and approval from campus community.
