You will receive a response to this request within 2-3 business days. Admissions will contact you by email if more information is needed to determine your residency. If you already registered, your nonresident fees will be reversed once your request is approved.

If request for California residency is denied, students may appeal decision to the Director, Admissions and Records. Appeals must be submitted within the term residency reclassification is requested.
