The next step is not determined yet, although Regina Vogue has a team working on a data research of 20 different colleges who have been utilizing the Early Alert system, and the “ZHAR” program. This is only a system, but it can be applied in many ways to guide and assist students. Also, the Help One Student Stay Survey is now available. Following this conversation the Committee continue to report on the Hate Graffiti, a new application will be available to report crime, services include GPS, and able to report anytime of the day. Starting March 1st, 2019, the Bookstore will continue business under new management. Huge concerns about “Connect”, which is an access code learning system, professors only ask for E-version. Update on AB 705 was passed in 2017 and the result for students having the right to access transfer level coursework. Next meeting will be held on November 14.</p>
