Who: Current Cuesta College Students

What: California Assembly Bill 705 was passed, which allows students to register directly into transfer-level math and English courses. [View Assembly Bill](#)

Why: New research shows that students are more likely to pass transfer-level math and English when placed directly into these classes. [View Research](#)

When: Colleges are required to make these changes to placement by Fall 2019. We would like to give you the opportunity to take advantage of these changes sooner.

How: Starting this Spring 2019, you are eligible to register in transfer-level math and English classes regardless of any placement you have received in the past. Access the class finder to view the schedule on October 26, 2018.

Where: Check out your Student Education Plan (SEP) within your myCuesta Pathway to view your planned classes. [View myCuesta Pathway Directions](#). If your SEP requires a transfer-level English or math course, you may select from the list below:

Note: You are welcome to stay on the math or English sequence you are already on or enroll in a higher-level preparatory course before enrolling in a transfer-level course.
