



## 2023 Scholarships

**Applications accepted (online only) from 2-1-23 to 4-15-23**

### Who can apply?

1. Must be a California resident.
2. High School Seniors and currently enrolled college students who are children of CCGGA Grower Members, including children whose parents or guardians are employees of a member nursery. Note: any major will be accepted in this category.
3. High School Seniors and currently enrolled college students pursuing an education in Horticulture, one of the Plant Sciences or Environmental Sciences. - Future educators in the plant sciences will be considered.
4. Students pursuing plant production, management or research careers are especially encouraged to apply.
5. Graduate students are not eligible.

### Criteria used to evaluate and score applications?

1. Scholarship / Academics
2. Leadership
3. Active in school activities (sports, clubs, etc.)
4. Active in agricultural related activities (FFA, 4-H, Hort Club, etc.) - Community Service
5. Clearly outlined future plans and goals (include in your essay)

3. Mail or Email Letters of Reference (Minimum of 2)

**Deadline is April 15, 2023 at midnight.** No late or incomplete applications will be accepted. All Transcripts and Letters of Reference must be received by the deadline to be considered. No postmarks after the deadline date will be accepted.
