



## **FIRST YEAR TO-DO LIST FOR CSU/UC TRANSFER**

### **1. Choose your major**

- Attend Career Lab to talk with a counselor about major and career options
- Take the Myers Briggs and Strong Interest Inventory assessments for free!
- Declare your major in your myCuesta Portal and use Pathways worksheet

### **2. Determine your universities**

- Take campus tours- virtual tours are available through campus websites
- Meet with Admissions Reps to ask questions about campuses and programs
- Learn the transfer requirements on campus websites

### **3. Make a Plan**

- Schedule an appointment with a counselor to make a Student Education Plan, and map out all of the courses you will need to take to transfer.
- Use [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) to learn required courses for UC/CSU admission and course articulation between Cuesta College & CSU/UC campuses by major
- Use <https://www.calpoly.edu/admissions> to see required/desired courses for each Cal Poly major. Plan to take all required/desired major courses!

### **4. Visit the University Transfer/Career Center**

- Resources include workshops, transfer information, computer lab, and staff that can answer your questions.

## **Transfer Tips**

1. Start strong! **Your transfer GPA is important**, and your first-year grades will have a big impact.
2. **Check out the Student Success Center** (free tutoring, Math Lab, Writing Center)
3. **Talk to your instructor** if you are having trouble with any courses.
4. If you need to drop a class, **consult with a walk-in counselor**.
