



FIRST YEAR TO-DO LIST FOR CSU/UC TRANSFER

1. Choose your major

- Attend a Career/Major Exploration Workshop to learn about options
- o Take the Myers Briggs and Strong Interest Inventory assessments for free!
- o Declare your major in your myCuesta Portal and use Pathways worksheet

2. <u>Determine your universities</u>

- o Research options on campus websites consider program, location, cost, etc.
- o Tour campuses or take a virtual tour online
- Meet with University Admissions Representatives if you have questions

3. Make a Plan

- Schedule a counseling appointment to make a Student Education Plan (to map out the courses needed to transfer)
- Learn major preparation requirements for UC/CSU admission on <u>www.assist.org</u>
- Use https://www.calpoly.edu/admissions to see required/desired courses for each Cal Poly major. Plan to take all required/desired major courses!

4. Visit the University Transfer/Career Center

- We offer workshops, a computer lab for student use, application assistance and many transfer resources

Transfer Tips

- 1. Start strong! **Your transfer GPA is important** and your first-year grades will have a big impact.
- 2. <u>Check out the Student Success Center</u> (free tutoring, Math Lab, Writing Center)
- 3. **Talk to your instructor** if you are having trouble with any courses
- 4. Consult with a walk-in counselor if you have quick questions
- 5. Make sure to **update your Student Education Plan** whenever you change your major or add a university to your list
